Dear Mr. McKenna:

It is my understanding that Spokane County Prosecutor Steve Tucker will be sending you the first degree manslaughter complaint I filed with the Spokane County Sheriff and Spokane City police chief on August 18, 2007.

I am enclosing a 207 page 86-exhibit document. This document establishes sufficient evidence of criminal activity, corruption and subsequent cover-ups involving specific members of the Cowles family and the Spokane County sheriff, prosecutor, police chief and Spokane Mayor. It also exposes and establishes an existing grave public danger in Spokane. This danger has been and continues to be covered up by the Cowles family and public officials.

Most importantly, I am enclosing a copy of a document I just received yesterday. This document, a statement by Rex Franklin - the former manager of the Cowles's parking garage, describes the conditions of the Cowle's garage as a literally proven and existing death-trap. This life-threatening statement has been concealed from the public by the Cowles family and public officials for almost three years. I have know of this document since 2007, however, had not seen it until yesterday, or I would have been far more adamant in my efforts to protect the public. The withholding of the Franklin document from the public and allowing the unsuspecting public to enter the Cowles parking garage on a daily basis, is a self-serving act of cowardice and contempt for life, by all those responsible.

At this time, with the receipt of my documentation, you now have clear knowledge of this grave and currently existing public danger. Since neither Cowles family members or public officials have failed to respond to my concerns, fulfill the obligations of their offices, honor their oaths of office, or respect the public's safety, I request that you take whatever action is necessary to close this garage down until the city is able to inspect it and determine if it is safe for the public to enter.

As you will see from the evidence I now present you, a pattern of practice has been established to allow the statute of limitations run out on my complaint. The statute of limitations is now down to less that two months remaining.

The evidence in my complaint is exceptionally strong and abundant, and now the evidence of a cover-up involving numerous public officials and Cowles family members is equally as strong.

Mr. McKenna, I strongly request that you carefully study my documentation and immediately act on my complaint. There is easily sufficient evidence and probable cause to indict numerous Cowles family members and public officials with felony crimes. Based on the evidence I have gathered and not provide you with, if the statute of limitations is allowed to lapse, it will have been provably allowed to lapse deliberately.

During my 25-year law enforcement career, this is the most morally reprehensible disregard for human life and public corruption I have witnesses in Eastern Washington. Please be assured that if you do not do your job with honor

and the highest of integrity your actions will be exposed.

In closing, I cannot overly stress how important it is for you to carefully study and act upon the information I am providing you. Please contact me if you have any questions.
